Official Settlement Proposal from Draper City:

- 1. Draper City will repair and maintain Traverse Ridge Road north of the 4-way stop sign and SunCrest Drive. "Repair and maintain" includes reconstruction.
- TRSSD would be responsible for all repair and maintenance associated with all public roads except Traverse Ridge Road north of the 4-way stop sign and Suncrest Drive.
 "Repair and maintenance" includes reconstruction. TRSSD will propose a tax rate increase that will generate an additional \$175,000 annually for this purpose.
- 3. TRSSD would be responsible for the incremental cost of snow plowing all public roads within TRSSD, including Traverse Ridge Road north of the 4-way stop sign and SunCrest Drive, using the current formula.
- 4. TRSSD would propose and support any tax rate increase necessary in order to cover the TRSSD's annual costs described in bullet points #2 and #3.

- 5. TRSSD would be responsible for the cost of maintaining the streetlights.
- 6. The TRSSD Administrative Control Board will be dissolved after the applicable tax rate increases are implemented. An advisory board would be created that would advise the mayor and city council on TRSSD matters.
